

RO STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The agreement

By taking part in the Realising Opportunities (RO) National Student Conference (NSC) 2022, you are agreeing to our Code of Conduct. This outlines how we expect all RO students in the NSC should behave. We do this to protect everyone taking part in the NSC 2022.

I agree:

- To be responsible for my own behaviour when using the iVent NSC platform on which the RO NSC 2022 will be hosted. This includes the resources I access and the language I use.
- I will not search for or share material considered to be offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across any such material, I must report it immediately to the RO Central Team.
- I will not give out any personal information via the NSC platform, such as name, phone number or address or anything information considered to be personal.
- I will not update my profile on the NSC platform.
- I will not give out any personal information relating to any other person.
- I will not reveal my passwords to anyone.
- I will not arrange a face-to-face meeting with someone I meet online at the NSC 2022.
- If I am concerned or upset about anything I see on the NSC platform or any messages that I receive, I must report it to the RO Central Team as soon as possible.
- I understand that live sessions will be recorded and kept on file for 12 months.

I understand that my use of the NSC platform, supplied by iVent and run by Realising Opportunities, will be monitored and logged and can be accessed by the organiser. I understand that these rules are to keep me and others safe and that if I choose not to follow them Realising Opportunities may contact my parents/carers and/or that my access to the online activity will be suspended.
