

How to complete Skills4Uni

What do you need to do?

You should work through the Skills4Uni course at <https://canvas.bham.ac.uk/courses/78776>. The course includes interactive quizzes, videos, tasks and information from real university students. You can access the course at any time. It's important that you work through the online course first, as the Skills4Uni multiple choice quiz covers the content of the Skills4Uni course.

How do you take the Skills4Uni multiple choice quiz?

When you have worked through the online course, you can access the multiple-choice quiz by logging in to the [RO student hub](#). You can [click here to see some information about logging in to the RO student hub](#) and you can watch a screencast about [how to take the quiz here](#).

You may see some quiz questions throughout the Skills4Uni course, but please note that this is separate to the Skills4Uni multiple choice quiz on the RO hub. You still need to complete the Skills4Uni quiz on the [RO student hub](#) after you have finished the course.

You need to achieve a score of 75% or above to pass the quiz. If you score lower than 75% you can take the quiz again, and feedback will be provided to help you. If you make 3 unsuccessful attempts at the quiz Jessica, your RO Ambassador, will get in touch with you to provide any you with some additional support.

Is there a deadline for completing the Skills4Uni quiz?

Skills4Uni is a core element of the RO programme. If you successfully complete the quiz by 31 July 2025 you will be automatically entered into a prize draw to win one of four £25 Amazon vouchers. Once you have completed the quiz your progress checker will automatically update on the RO student hub.

How will it help you?

By completing the Skills4Uni course and quiz you will:

- Increase your confidence in working on research-based projects.
- Develop your skills in planning, research and referencing that will help you complete your EPQ or Academic Assignment successfully.
- Have a greater understanding of what to expect at university.
